RFP for Seawall Repairs

Q: Please consider extending the bid opening time to 2:30PM for FedEx delivery.

A: Please make arrangements to have your bid in at the listed date and time. The bid date and time will not be changed.

Q: The RFP Section IX requires the submittal of sheet pile test data with the bid. We plan on using the as-specified ESP vinyl and have simply copied generic test data obtained from the manufacturer's website. Is this OK?

A: Yes, this information is acceptable as long as it adequately shows that the material meets the minimum properties called for in the specifications.

Q: Is there an engineer's cost estimate or budget for this project?

A: Yes, all CIP project budgets can be found on the City Website (www.stpetebeach.org) located under Administrative Services Department, Finance. <http://www.stpetebeach.org/images/stories/fy2013-budget.pdf> FY2013 budget for seawalls is \$10,000 for engineering and \$70,000 for construction.

Q: Sheet 6, seawall section view, calls for ESP 8.5 Vinyl Sheets for the 27th Ave. seawall while sheet 5 notes call for ESP 6.5. Which vinyl sheet shall be used?

A: Utilize what is being specified in the notes, sheet 5, ESP 6.5.

Note: Sheet 7 – Contractor shall provide crushed shell fill in landscape area following completion of seawall and restoration work. Small crushed shell shall be a total of 3" deep in planter area.
