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The City of St. Pete Beach has a vacancy on the City Commission for the seat of Commissioner, District 2, effective January 8, 2019. The City Commission may or may not interview candidates in the Commission Chambers prior to the regular City Commission meeting on Tuesday, January 8, 2019. The selection and Oath of Office will be given to the successful candidate at the regular meeting beginning at 6:00 p.m.
