

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-21


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA;
ESTABLISHING THE AD VALOREM TAX LEVY FOR THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2009 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2010:
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That a levy of 2.4834 operating mills and 0.0754 debt service mills be placed upon the total taxable assessed valuation of real and personal property lying within the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, and said monies as raised by the 2.4834 mills be estimated at \$5,509,922 to be used for the general operation of the City of St. Pete Beach including salaries, insurance and energy costs and transfers for capital projects for the aforementioned fiscal period and said monies as raised by the 0.0754 debt service mills be estimated at \$168,325 to be used for financing general obligation bonds for the Police Building. The operating millage rate reflects a 7.04 percent decrease over the rolled-back rate, which represents an equivalent decrease in property taxes.

Section 2. That a certified copy of this ordinance be forwarded to the Tax Assessor of Pinellas County, Florida, together with a request that the aforementioned levies be made by his/her office on behalf of the City of St. Pete Beach for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010.


Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage.
