

Ordinance 2010-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR DELETION OF CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE XI, SECTIONS 22-171 THRU 22-179 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, PERTAINING TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP COMMITTEE, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, it is the desire to dissolve the Environmental Stewardship Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1. Article XI, Sections 22-171 thru 22-179 of the code of Ordinances of the City of St. Pete Beach, Florida be eliminated in its entirety.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict.


Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
