

**CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA  
ORDINANCE NO. 2011-27**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 82, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 2, SECTION 82-171, FINES FOR VIOLATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission wishes to update the City's fines for certain violations pertaining to the City's parking regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission has found that this Ordinance to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of St. Pete Beach;

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:**

**SECTION 82-171 FINES FOR VIOLATIONS**

**Section 1.** Chapter 82, Article III, Division 2, Section 82-171 of the Code of Ordinances, City of St. Pete Beach, Florida is hereby amended as follows:

**82-171: Fines for violations:**


<b>The following fines shall be charged for certain parking violations:</b>		<b>After 15 Days</b>
(1) Overtime parking	<del>\$25.00</del> <b><u>\$30.00</u></b>	<del>\$40.00</del> <b><u>\$45.00</u></b>
(2) Improper parking	<del>\$25.00</del> <b><u>\$30.00</u></b>	<del>\$40.00</del> <b><u>\$45.00</u></b>
(3) Double parking	\$40.00	\$55.00
(4) No parking zone	<del>\$25.00</del> <b><u>\$30.00</u></b>	<del>\$40.00</del> <b><u>\$45.00</u></b>
(5) Motor running, unattended	<del>\$25.00</del> <b><u>\$30.00</u></b>	<del>\$40.00</del> <b><u>\$45.00</u></b>
(6) Keys in ignition	<del>\$25.00</del> <b><u>\$30.00</u></b>	<del>\$40.00</del> <b><u>\$45.00</u></b>
(7) Other	<del>\$25.00</del> <b><u>\$30.00</u></b>	<del>\$40.00</del> <b><u>\$45.00</u></b>
(8) Parking for space reserved for disabled persons:	\$255.00	\$270.00

(9) Parking in front of fire hydrant:	\$100.00	\$115.00
(10) Parking on streets or lots restricted to specific permit parking:	\$40.00	\$55.00

**Section 2.** If any portion, part or section of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the valid remainder hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption as provided by law.
