AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ST PETE BEACH
RELATING TO A LAWSUIT BETWEEN WALTER SOWA
AND THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH; APPROVING A
CONTINGENT MEDIATION SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT BY ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR

settlement agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A; and


THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA
