

**CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA
ORDINANCE 2012-20**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 74 – STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, ARTICLE I – IN GENERAL, SECTION 74-2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, PROHIBITING BICYCLE RIDING ON THE CITY SIDEWALK THAT IS WEST OF THE PRIVATE PROPERTIES ON SUNSET WAY BETWEEN 28TH AVENUE AND 30TH AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT HERewith, TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, notice of this Ordinance has been provided in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the city desires to prohibit bicycle riding on the city sidewalk that is west of the private properties on Sunset Way between 28th Avenue and 30th Avenue. Specifically, the city sidewalk located between 27°42'07.96" N 82°44'13.77" W and 27°42'17.64" N 82°44'14.14" W; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has found this Ordinance to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:


Section 1. Section 74-2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of St. Pete Beach, Florida, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 74-2 – ~~Reserved~~ Bicycle riding is prohibited on the city sidewalk west of the private properties on Sunset Way between 28th Avenue and 30th Avenue.

Section 2. If any portion, part or section of the Ordinance is declared invalid, the valid remainder hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
