

RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR BALLOT QUESTIONS AND BALLOT SUMMARIES FOR JUNE 3, 2008 SPECIAL ELECTION FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PROVIDING FOR A STATE MANDATED PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES ELEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, State law requires local governments to provide comprehensive plan provisions that provide for coordination of public school facilities among the school district and local governments;

WHEREAS, the City Commission has, following extensive research and public discussion, determined that amendment of the Comprehensive Plan provisions pertaining to public school facilities is in the best interest of the citizens of the City;

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach conferred with the Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections and determined that the earliest practicable date to present the ordinances to the voters is June 3, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The following measure shall be placed on the special election ballot for June 3, 2008 to be voted upon by the qualified electors of the City of St. Pete Beach, Florida:

BALLOT SUMMARY:

Section 2. The City Clerk shall notify the Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections of this Resolution and provide the ballot questions provided hereby.


Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon final passage as required by law.
