

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FOR A MARINA AT THE CITY COMMUNITY CENTER.

WHEREAS, the recent real estate trend for residential waterfront development has severely impacted the number of public boat clips in Pinellas County, and;

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach recognizes this deficiency and is interested in pursuing opportunities to meet this growing demand and;

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach has identified the publicly owned site where the new Community Center was constructed as a very desirable location, and;

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach desires to apply for a Florida Boating Improvement Program Grant to assist with funding of such a facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of St. Pete Beach as follows:


The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to apply for a Florida Boating Improvement Program Grant on behalf of the City of St. Pete Beach.
