

RESOLUTION 2009-01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, it had been contemplated that there would be held a referendum in conjunction with the municipal election on March 10, 2009 for the purpose of seeking voter approval of a City of St. Pete Beach Comprehensive Plan Amendment for Community Redevelopment District-Eighth Avenue as submitted by Ordinance 2008-24 and

WHEREAS, there will be no general municipal election on March 10, 2009; and

WHEREAS, it is not in the public interest to hold a special election for the sole purpose of seeking voter approval of such measure;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH:**

**SECTION 1: REMOVAL OF REFERENDUM MEASURE FROM
BALLOT AND CANCELATION OF REFERENDUM ELECTION.** The ballot question entitled CITY OF ST. BEACH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT-EIGHTH AVENUE as submitted by Ordinance 2008-24 shall be removed from the general election to be held on March 10,

2009 to be submitted for a later special or general election. The referendum election to be held on March 10, 2009 for approval of such ballot question is canceled and the Supervisor of Elections shall be notified and requested to take all appropriate action to cancel such election.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Commission.
