

RESOLUTION 2009-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA; DECLARING THE CANDIDATES ELECTED AS CITY COMMISSIONER FOR DISTRICTS 2 AND 4; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a general election for the election of commissioners from Districts 2 and 4 was scheduled to be held on March 10, 2009; and

WHEREAS, there will be no general municipal election on March 10, 2009 because only one candidate qualified for election from each of said districts; and

WHEREAS, the state law as well as the city code provide that when only one candidate qualifies for election, no election shall be held and the qualified candidate shall be deemed elected; and

WHEREAS, the city charter provides that commissioners are elected for two year terms of office; and

WHEREAS, City Code Section 38-16 provides that newly elected commissioners shall be installed at the first regularly scheduled city commission meeting after completion of the election.

WHEREAS, The first regularly scheduled city commission meeting after the date of the scheduled election will be held on March 24, 2009.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST PETE BEACH:

Section 1: DECLARATION OF RESULT OF GENERAL ELECTION.

The results of the scheduled election in March 2009 for commissioners from districts 2 and 4 are:

District 2 Jim Parent- only qualified candidate.

District 4 Bev Garnett only qualified candidate.

Jim Parent and Bev Garnett are deemed elected from their respective districts in that they were the only candidates to qualify to run for office in their districts. They shall be installed on March 24, 2009.

Section 2: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Commission.
