

Resolution 2009-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING PARTICIPATION IN THE FLORIDA CITY COUNTY MANAGEMENT DISASTER RECOVERY TEAM, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO IMPLEMENT NECESSARY ACTIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ACTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida City County Management Association (FCCMA), the Florida League of Cities (FLC), and the Florida Association of Counties (FAC) have formed a partnership to provide disaster recovery resources to local governments in need after a catastrophic event; and

WHEREAS, the types of resources that are anticipated for this Plan include, but is not limited to, the following local government capabilities; Information Technology, Property Appraisers, Finance, Budget, Accounting, Grant writing, Management/Administration, Building Inspectors, Public Works, Utilities, Procurement, Inventory Control, Fleet Management; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Recovery Plan (DRP) focuses on in-state mutual aid utilizing the Florida Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the plan is supported by the State of Florida and the Division of Emergency Management and a position has been set aside in the State EOC at the mutual aid desk for a representative of the FCCMA to facilitate the response of resources to other local governments in the event of an activation and request for resources; and

WHEREAS, the plan is based on a regional concept using the seven (7) regions established by the Division of Emergency Management for the State Emergency Response Teams; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach is located in Florida State Emergency Management Region four; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach recognizes the vulnerability of the people and communities located within the State of Florida to damage, injury, and loss of life and property resulting from a disaster event, and recognizes that these events may present equipment and resource requirements beyond the capacity of each individual government;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. AUTHORIZATION TO PARTICIPATE. The St. Pete Beach City Commission hereby authorizes the City of St. Pete Beach to participate in the Florida City County Management Association Disaster Recovery Plan through participation in

the provision of equipment, vehicles and/or personnel if available at the time of request as coordinated at the Regional level.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section or portion of a section of this resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or part of this resolution


Section 3. CONFLICTS. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the City Commission


