


RESOLUTION NO. 2009-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE DATE FOR THE 2010 GENERAL ELECTION AND THE QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR SAID ELECTION FOR CITY DISTRICTS NO. 1 AND NO. 3.


The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, in a regular meeting held Monday, November 30, 2009 resolves as follows:

1. A City Election will be held on Tuesday, March 9, 2010 for the purpose of electing Commissioners for City Districts No. 1 and No. 3. (If necessary, a runoff election will be held on Tuesday, April 13, 2010.) (City Code Section 38-7, 38-8 and 38-14)
2. Every person who shall be a candidate for the Office of City Commissioner shall file the necessary papers with the City Clerk not earlier than 8:00am on December 8, 2009, and not later than 12:00 noon on December 30, 2009.
3. To qualify for the position of City Commissioner, a candidate must have been a full-time resident of the District in which he/she seeks to represent for a period of twelve (12) months next preceding the last day of the established qualifying period. (City Charter Section 3.02)
