

**RESOLUTION NO. 2010 – 02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR A BALLOT QUESTION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY AT A SPECIAL ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE FORM OF A BALLOT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach Charter Section Sec. 3.16 provides that a community redevelopment plan as defined in Florida Statutes Section 163 shall not be adopted by the City Commission until such proposed community redevelopment plan is submitted to a vote of the electors by referendum as provided by Florida Statute Section 166.031 or by the City Charter.

WHEREAS, City Commission has determined that approval of the community redevelopment plan proposed by Resolution No. 2010- 01 is necessary for the preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, HEREBY RESOLVES:**

**Section 1.** The following ballot question shall be placed on the Special Election ballot a City Special Election to be held on March 9, 2010:

**QUESTION NO. 1  
CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH  
COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT PLAN**

The City Commission adopted Resolution 2010- 01 proposing the adoption by the City Commission of a community redevelopment plan for the community redevelopment area (CRA) of the City. Shall the community redevelopment plan for the community redevelopment area (CRA) of the City as proposed for adoption by Resolution 2010- 01 be adopted by the City Commission.


