

RESOLUTION 2010-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING A BILL DESIGNATING THE COMMAND SERGEANT MAJOR GARY LEE LITTRELL MEDAL OF HONOR CAUSEWAY AND BRIDGE IN PINELLAS COUNTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Congressional Medal of Honor is the highest of all U.S. Military decorations, and

WHEREAS, the Congressional Medal of Honor is bestowed to only those individuals who exhibit extraordinary strength and courage at the risk of life and above and beyond the call of duty in a conflict against an enemy of the United States; and

WHEREAS, Command Sergeant Major Gary Lee Littrell received the Congressional Medal of Honor for bravely serving his Country; and


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of St. Pete Beach, Florida, that it supports a bill to provide that:

1. The portion of State Road 682 (Pinellas Bayway) from State Road 699 (Gulf Boulevard) to U.S. 19 in Pinellas County be designated as "Command Sergeant Major Gary Lee Littrell Medal of Honor Causeway and Bridge; and
2. The Department of Transportation be directed to erect suitable markers designating the Command Sergeant Major Gary Lee Littrell Medal of Honor Causeway and Bridge.
