

RESOLUTION 2010-12

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH,
PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A RESERVE
TO THE GENERAL FUND BALANCE FOR LIBRARY
PURCHASES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, at a regular meeting held Tuesday, March 23, 2010, resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Roberta Whipple served as the Library Administrator for the City of St. Pete Beach for over fifteen years until her untimely death from cancer on December 16, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the outpouring of love from the community has resulted in the City accepting donations in her honor from residents, patrons and colleagues; and

WHEREAS, it was Roberta's wish that these monies be expended only on extraordinary items for the benefit of patrons of the St. Pete Beach library.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1. The monies donated in loving memory of Roberta Whipple shall be used exclusively toward extraordinary items outside those routinely budgeted for in the normal operation of the library as requested by the Library Administrator or his/her designee.

Section 2. The City Commission shall formally approve any such expenditure in a public meeting.

Section 3. A reserve shall be established at the end of the fiscal year for any monies not spent, including interest earning thereon, which shall be available in future years for extraordinary library expenditures following City Commission approval.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
