

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE VOTES CAST IN A SPECIAL REFERENDA ELECTION ON ONE REFERENDUM QUESTION.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida in a regular meeting duly assembled on Tuesday, March 23, 2010, resolves as follows:

Whereas, there was a Special Mail Ballot Election held on March 9, 2010 in St. Pete Beach for determination of one referendum question based on the authority of Ordinance 2010-1; and

Whereas, The City Commission previously authorized the County Canvassing Board to canvass and provide the results of the March 9, 2010 Special Election.

Now, **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the votes cast in the Citywide Election are as follows:

Total votes no:	<u>936</u>	% of votes cast:	<u>33.99%</u>


