

RESOLUTION 2010-18
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY,
FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A RESERVE TO THE GENERAL FUND
BALANCE FOR SWIMMING POOL PURCHASES AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, at a regular meeting held Tuesday, May 25, 2010, resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Wendy Johnson served on the City of St. Pete Beach's Recreation Advisory Committee for several years and most recently she served as the Chairperson of this Committee until her untimely death from cancer on April 4, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the outpouring of love from the community has resulted in the City accepting donations in her honor from residents, patrons and colleagues; and

WHEREAS, it was Mrs. Johnson's wish that these monies be expended only on extraordinary items at the St. Pete Beach swimming pool.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1. The monies donated in loving memory of Wendy Johnson shall be used exclusively toward extraordinary items outside those routinely budgeted for in the normal operation of the swimming pool.

Section 2. The City Commission shall formally approve any such expenditure in a public meeting.

Section 3. A reserve shall be established at the end of the fiscal year for any monies not spent, including interest earning thereon, which shall be available in future years for extraordinary swimming pool expenditures following City Commission approval.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
