

**RESOLUTION 2010-26**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE DATE FOR THE 2011 GENERAL ELECTION AND THE QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR COMMISSIONERS FOR DISTRICT NO. 2 AND DISTRICT NO. 4 AND MAYOR.**

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County Florida, in a regular meeting held on Tuesday, October 12, 2010 resolves as follows:


1. A City Election will be held on Tuesday, March 8, 2011 for the purpose of electing Commissioners for City Districts No. 2 and No. 4, and Mayor. (If necessary, a runoff election will be held on Tuesday, April 12, 2011) (City Code Section 38-7, 38-8 and 38-14)
2. Every person who shall be a candidate for the Office of City Commissioner or Mayor shall file the necessary papers with the City Clerk not earlier than 8:00am on December 6, 2010 and not later than 12:00 noon on December 15, 2010.
3. To qualify for the position of City Commissioner, a candidate must have been a full-time resident of the District in which he/she seeks to represent for a period of twelve (12) months next preceding the last day of the established qualifying period. To qualify for the position of Mayor, a candidate must have been a full-time resident of the City for a period of twelve (12) months next preceding the last day of the established qualifying period.
