

RESOLUTION 2010-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, NOMINATING PATRICIA J. SHONTZ, MAYOR OF MADEIRA BEACH TO REPRESENT THE CITIES OF ST. PETE BEACH, TREASURE ISLAND AND MADEIRA BEACH ON THE PINELLAS PLANNING COUNCIL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Pinellas Planning Council (PPC) has requested the Cities of Madeira Beach, Treasure Island, and St. Pete Beach nominate a single candidate to represent our communities on the PPC from January 2011 through December 2012; and

WHEREAS, Patricia J. Shontz has expressed her desire to continue as the representative on the PPC; and

WHEREAS, as such, St. Pete Beach would like to nominate Mayor Patricia J. Shontz to represent Madeira Beach, St. Pete Beach, and Treasure Island on the Pinellas Planning Council; and


WHEREAS, upon the completion of the term of an appointee (either by removal from the relevant City Commission or by reaching the final date of the appointees term of City office) the three cities intend that the next appointment be an elected official of the next City in the rotation.


