
WHEREAS, it has been determined that said public services department vehicle and city clerk's office microfilm reader may be disposed of.

NOW, THEREFORE the City Commission of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, at its regular meeting duly called provides as follows:


BE IT RESOLVED:
