


RESOLUTION NO. 2011-21

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE DATE FOR THE 2012 GENERAL ELECTION AND THE QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR COMMISSIONERS FOR DISTRICT 1 AND DISTRICT 3.**

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County Florida, in a regular meeting held on Tuesday, November 8, 2011 resolves as follows:

1. A City Election will be held on Tuesday, January 31, 2012 for the purpose of electing Commissioners for City Districts No. 1 and No. 3. (If necessary, a runoff election will be held within 60 days of said election) (City Code Section 38-7, 38-8 and 38.14).
2. Every person who shall be a candidate for the Office of City Commissioner shall file the necessary papers with the City Clerk not earlier than 8:00a.m. on November 14, 2011 and not later than 12:00 noon on November 30, 2011.
3. To qualify for the position of City Commissioner, a candidate must have been a full-time resident of the District in which he/she seeks to represent for a period of twelve (12) months next preceding the last day of the established qualifying period.
