

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR TRIM NOTICES

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, in a meeting held July 10, 2012, resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, a tentative budget has been prepared for the City as contemplated by s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat.; and


WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to comply with the requirements of s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat.; and

WHEREAS, the proposed millage rate for the City of St. Pete Beach, as described in s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat. is computed to be a rate of 3.5628 mills and a voted debt service millage rate of .0878 mills.


NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DOES RESOLVE:

The City Commission specifies a proposed millage rate as described in s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat.; of 3.5628 mills and a voted debt service millage rate of .0878 mills and authorizes notification of the Pinellas County Property Appraiser of the proposed tentative millage rate of 3.5628 mills and the voted debt service millage rate of .0878 mill for a total of 3.6506 mills for use in the Truth in Millage Notices.
