

**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-11**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR TRIM NOTICES**

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, in a meeting held July 23, 2013, resolves as follows:

**WHEREAS**, a tentative budget has been prepared for the City as contemplated by s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat.; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission wishes to comply with the requirements of s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat.; and


**WHEREAS**, the proposed millage rate for the City of St. Pete Beach, as described in s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat. is computed to be a rate of 2.8569 mills.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DOES RESOLVE:**

The City Commission specifies a proposed millage rate as described in s. 200.065(2)(a)1, Fla. Stat.; of 2.8569 mills and authorizes notification of the Pinellas County Property Appraiser of the proposed tentative millage rate of 2.8569 for use in the Truth in Millage Notices.
