

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING THE DATE FOR THE 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION, THE RUNOFF ELECTION, AND THE QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR THE MAYOR-COMMISSIONER AND THE COMMISSIONERS FOR DISTRICT 1 AND DISTRICT 3.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County Florida, in a regular meeting held on Tuesday, September 3, 2013 resolves as follows:


1. A City Election will be held on Tuesday, March 11, 2014 for the purpose of electing a Mayor-Commissioner and Commissioners for City Districts No. 1 and No. 3. (If necessary, a runoff election will be held on April 8, 2014) (City Code Section 38-7, 38-8 and 38.14).
2. Every person who shall be a candidate for the Office of Mayor-Commissioner and for City Commissioner shall file the necessary papers with the City Clerk not earlier than 12:00 p.m., noon, on December 9, 2013 and not later than 12:00 p.m., noon, on December 13, 2013.
3. To qualify for the position of Mayor-Commissioner, a candidate must have been a full-time resident of the City of St. Pete Beach, Florida for a period of twelve (12) months next preceding the last day of the established qualifying period; to qualify for the position of City Commissioner, a candidate must have been a full-time resident of the District in which s/he seeks to represent for a period of twelve (12) months next preceding the last day of the established qualifying period.
