

RESOLUTION 2013-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH,
PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING A PLAN FOR A
COMPREHENSIVE EXPANSION AND RENOVATION OF THE
ST. PETE BEACH LIBRARY FACILITY AND ADJACENT
PARKING AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, at a regular meeting held Tuesday, February 12, 2013, resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the library collections, services and programs have demonstrated value to the community and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the current library building is forty-five years old, with only a minor refurbishment done two decades ago; and

WHEREAS, the style of the facility originally built in the 1960's preceded the ubiquity of technology and escalating demand for information access, instruction, and space as well as multi-formatted materials in the twenty first century.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1. The City Commission supports the plan for a comprehensive expansion and renovation of the current St. Pete Beach Library facility and adjacent parking area as a fundamental step in the future delivery of library services to residents.


