A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH. THE APPOINTMENT RECOMMENDING **OF** MEMBER TO THE JOINT PINELLAS COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the joint Pinellas County MPO/PPC was established by amendment of the PPC'S Special Act; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the new consolidated board required reapportionment of the MPO membership, which must be done in conformance with Section 339.175, Florida Statues; and

WHEREAS, the Pinellas County MPO desires to reapportion the board membership to provide representation for all local governments in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Pinellas County MPO has approved a Membership Reapportionment Plan which provides for the addition of two members, one representing the cities of Belleair, Belleair Bluffs, Gulfport, Kenneth City, Seminole and South Pasadena and another representing the cities of Belleair Beach, Belleair Shore, Indian Rocks Beach, Indian Shores, Madeira Beach, North Redington Beach, Redington Beach, Redington Shores, St. Pete Beach and Treasure Island, bringing the total voting membership to 13.

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

- 1. The City of St. Pete Beach approves the nomination of Mayor Maria Lowe as the representative to the joint board.
- 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and adoption.
