

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-07**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR TRIM NOTICES**

The Board of Commissioners of the City of St. Pete Beach, Pinellas County, Florida, in a meeting held July 22, 2014, resolves as follows:

**WHEREAS**, a tentative budget has been prepared for the City as contemplated by Section 200.065(2)(a)1, Florida Statutes; and,


**WHEREAS**, the City Commission wishes to comply with the requirements of Section 200.065(2)(a)1, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed millage rate for the City of St. Pete Beach, as described in Section 200.065(2)(a)1, Florida Statutes is computed to be a rate of 3.2 mills.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, COUNTY OF PINELLAS COUNTY, STATE OF FLORIDA, DOES RESOLVE:**

The City Commission specifies a proposed millage rate as described in Section 200.065(2)(a)1, Florida Statutes, of 3.2 mills and authorizes notification of the Pinellas County Property Appraiser of the proposed tentative millage rate of 3.2 for use in the Truth in Millage Notices.
