

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION GRANT, AND ENTER INTO A HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION COUNCIL GRANT, LANDSCAPE CONSTRUCTION, AND MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips within Florida Department of Transportation rights of way should be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, SR699 (Blind Pass Road) between 82nd Avenue and Captiva Circle serve as main thoroughfares in St. Pete Beach; and

WHEREAS, FDOT owns SR699 (Blind Pass Road) between 82nd Avenue and Captiva Circle consisting of road improvements, medians and grassed areas abutting thereon located between SR699 (Blind Pass Road) between 82nd Avenue and Captiva Circle; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Pete Beach desires to further improve SR699 (Blind Pass Road) between 82nd Avenue and Captiva Circle through the installation of landscaping in its medians; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of St. Pete Beach has authorized the City Manager to apply for a Highway Beautification Council Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation, and to enter into a Highway Beautification Grant, Landscape Construction, and Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the City of St. Pete Beach and the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Commission of the City of St. Pete Beach reaffirms its authorization for the City Manager to apply for a Highway Beautification Council Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation, to accept the grant and enter into a Highway Beautification Grant, Landscape Construction, and Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the City of St. Pete Beach and the Florida Department of Transportation, which was executed on or about April 12, 2016.

Section 2. The City Clerk of City of St. Pete Beach is hereby directed to send copies of this Resolution to the Florida Department of Transportation and all other persons as directed by the City Commission or City Manager.


Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
