

RESOLUTION 2018-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, CONFIRMING THE 2019 ELECTION DATE; ESTABLISHING THE DATE FOR THE 2019 RUNOFF ELECTION, IF NECESSARY; ESTABLISHING THE QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR COMMISSIONERS IN DISTRICTS 2 AND 4; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, A Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, March 12, 2019 for the purpose of electing a Commissioner in District 2 and a Commissioner in District 4; and,

WHEREAS, a Runoff Election, if necessary, will be held on April 9, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the Qualification Period will be held from 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 29, 2018 through 12:00 p.m. on Friday, December 7, 2018; every person who shall be a candidate for commissioner shall file the necessary papers with the Office of the City Clerk during this period; and,

WHEREAS, to qualify for the position of Commissioner for District 2 or District 4, a candidate must be a full-time resident of the district in which s/he seeks to represent for a period of twelve (12) months next preceding the last day of the established qualifying period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of St. Pete Beach, that:

Section One: The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section Two: The City Commission of the City of St. Pete Beach, Florida hereby establishes March 12, 2019 as the date of the Municipal Election; establishes April 9, 2019 as the date for the runoff election; and establishes the Qualification Period as 12:00 p.m., Thursday, November 29, 2018 through 12:00 p.m., Friday, December 7, 2018.

Section Three: This resolution will be effective immediately upon adoption.




