-PEG CREED PARK DEDICATION MONDAY, JANUARY 14TH AT 4:00PM - At the September 25, 2012 City Commission meeting the Commission approved a request from the Friends of the Gulf Beaches Historical Museum, Inc. to dedicate the street end park at 90th Avenue in Peg Creed's honor. Peg's dedication to St. Pete Beach since moving here in 1952 is well known throughout the city. She volunteered with the city for 30 years; serving on the City's Beautification Committee, Recreation Committee, Honor Walk Committee, Personnel Review Board, Volunteer Response Team and the City's 40th Anniversary committee, three times a week worked the city's switchboard and was involved in many other city activities. Peg received the City's Volunteer of the Year award eight times and in 2004 received the Pinellas County's Senior Volunteer Service Award.

-THE CITY WILL BE GOING BACK TO THE PREVIOUS TRASH COLLECTION SCHEDULE THAT WE HAD PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1, 2012. All trash on the north side of the City will be collected on Monday/Thursday from Blind Pass Bridge down to 55th Ave including Aloha, Leilani and Pali Way starting on Monday, February 4th. The north side recycling day will now be Monday for all customers on the north side and begins Monday, February 11th. All trash on the south side of the City will continue to be collected on Tuesday/Friday from 52nd Ave down to 1st Ave with the recycling day on Friday.
