SCHEME TO DEFRAUD

There have been multiple incidents since 11/24/2014 in which an unknown male makes contact with a victim by phone, advising a family member has been in an accident, is injured, and has injured the caller's child.

The suspect, possibly Hispanic, states various things to the victim such as he is an EMT or Paramedic and asks, "Is there someone who would have you listed as next of kin?", he and/or another family member are in contact with the accident victim and are causing bodily harm to that person, and/or they are holding the person at gunpoint.

The caller then demands the victim to send a large sum of money (\$2000 - \$4000) from their bank through Western Union. The suspect will stay on the phone with the victim while waiting for the transfer to go through however he will hang up due to questions asked by the victim and/or Western Union putting a hold on the transfer.

The victim's caller id reflects the suspect phone number to be (727) 252-6688. The victims have stated the suspect speaks with a Spanish or Southern accent.

Information has been posted on Facebook by Clearwater Police Department, Tarpons Springs Police Department and the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office regarding this scheme to defraud.
