- RECLAIMED WATER SHORTAGE - The City of St Pete Beach owns and operates its reclaimed water distribution system, but we purchase the reclaimed water from Pinellas County under a wholesale agreement. During recent months, very limited rainfall in the reclaimed water service area has increased customer demand. Storage levels of reclaimed water have been rapidly declining, to the point of exhausting the reclaimed water in storage. While the City of St Pete Beach is not mandating reclaimed water restrictions at this time, we strongly encourage our residents to conserve as much reclaimed water as possible. It is important to note that if Pinellas County runs out of reclaimed water for the City of St Pete Beach to purchase, then City of St Pete Beach reclaimed water customers will be without reclaimed water during these times. As a result, it's critical that we all do what we can to use only the absolute minimum amount of reclaimed water in the coming months.
