Safe Walking Tips

Always stop, look to the LEFT, to the RIGHT, and to the LEFT again.

Stay within the crosswalk and briskly walk straight across the street.

Wear bright colored clothing.

When walking at night, carry a lighted flashlight and wear reflective clothing.

Walk facing traffic.

Watch for vehicles backing up.

Don't walk near traffic after taking medication or drinking alcohol.

Don't assume a driver will see you.

Always stop at the curb or the edge of the road.

-NEW PARKING METER SERVICE—The City of St. Pete Beach has implemented a new Parkmobile service that will allow residents and visitors to save time by using their mobile phones to pay for parking at coin operated meters throughout the City. To use the new Parkmobile system, register for free at www.Parkmobile.com or download the mobile app. Once registered, motorists can use a mobile app, the internet, or a toll free phone call 1-877-727-5714 to pay for parking. The phone number and parking zone is displayed on every coin operated parking meter. After setting up an account, motorists can immediately start using the system with a registered mobile phone. Motorists can also select an option to receive text message alerts and reminders fifteen minutes before their time expires. Motorists can track parking expenses and print reports through Parkmobile's secure site. Coin operated meters are located along Pass A Grille Way, Gulf Winds Drive, Sunset Way, 51st, 64th, and 66th Avenues. The City will be interfacing the new Parkmobile system with the multi-space Pay stations in the near future.
