**WHEREAS**, the BIGP FBIP grant application is time sensitive as the application cycle ends on April 4, 2022.

**WHEREAS**, the City believes it is in the best interest of the citizens to apply for a the BIGP FBIP grant in order to evaluate the location and/or re-design of the Don CeSar Boat Ramp.


SECTION 1. Recitals. The above recitals ("Whereas" clauses) are true and correct and adopted hereby as findings, purpose and intent of the City Commission.


